The techniques, in which the participants will be trained, comprise new methods of GI endoscopy such as Endoscopic Mucosal Resection (EMR), Endoscopic Submucosal Dissection (ESD), and Endoscopic polypectomy and POEM (Peroral Endoscopic Myotomy).

This course is primarily addressed to gastroenterologists-endoscopists who wish to broaden their knowledge in endoscopy.
